DORCHESTER TENNIS & SOUASH CLUB POLICY ON THE USE OF CHANGING ROOMS

Dorchester Tennis & Squash Club strives to ensure that all children are safeguarded from abuse and have an enjoyable tennis experience.

This document sets out the Dorchester Tennis & Squash Club policy for the acceptable use of our changing rooms.

- 1. Adults and children need to share our changing rooms and will therefore do so at different times.
- 2. Under no circumstances will adult staff, coaches or volunteers change or shower at the same time as children using the changing rooms.
- 3. Mixed gender groups of children will have access to separate changing rooms.
- 4. If we are made aware that a child or adult self-identifies as a gender that differs from the gender they were assigned at birth, we will work with them and their parents/carers (where it relates to a child) to make reasonable adjustments to changing arrangements to suit their needs.
- 5. Mobile phones and other electronic devices must not be used in changing rooms. Photography and video recording is forbidden in the changing rooms.
- 6. For younger groups of children, a DBS checked member of staff or volunteer will wait outside the changing rooms to allow children to call for assistance if required.
- 7. Where no changing facilities are available children, parents and travelling teams/players will be made aware prior to the game and advised to make alternative arrangements and to take appropriate additional clothing e.g. tracksuits etc.
